### Links Between COR™ Elements

An effective health and safety management system is the key to a safe workplace. It does not just happen, it must be designed and tested and improved. This session is intended to provide information on the links between specific COR™ elements. A health and safety management system is intended to provide a framework to address and organization's risks, and is made up of 19 related elements.

Explore the links between the COR™ elements and learn how to maximize the relationship between elements.

### Occupational Health and COR™

Occupational disease is the number one killer in the construction industry, and is a key component in the COR audit program. This session is designed to assist with identifying occupational health hazards and the key concepts to consider when developing controls and implementing a framework to address identified occupational health risks.

### Workplace Observations and Interviews

Conducting workplace observations and interviews are two verification techniques required to perform your COR™ Internal Audit. This session will assist you in conducting your own internal observations and interviews as well as prepare for your COR™ External Audit.
