Up-to-date certificates will need to be supplied every three years for the maintenance portion of the certificate. Failure to do so will result in your NCSO status becoming inactive. In the case of First Aid/CPR, a certificate from an organization approved by the WSIB must be produced. IHSA will accept certificates, records of training, training transcripts or equivalent. - ** In February 2015, the Canadian federal government introduced changes to WHMIS. There will be a transition period (until December 1, 2018) during which time IHSA's WHMIS course will teach a combination of the old WHMIS 1998 system and the new WHMIS 2015 system. After the transition period, only WHMIS 2015 will be taught.
- ∞ These courses must be approved by the Chief Prevention Officer of Ontario and meet the requirements as laid out in Ontario's Working at Heights Training Standard and JHSC Certification Training Standard. For this reason, no out-of-province working at heights course or JHSC certification can be accepted.
