## The Driving Hazard Identification, Risk Analysis and Control Worksheet

#### This worksheet is intended to:

- assist an organization in identifying the primary driving hazards that employees driving for work face;
- help the company list the likely frequency, probability, and severity of each hazard;
- rate the risk score of each hazard:
- think about logical control measures;
- document implementation processes
- identify processes for monitoring and continuous improvement.

#### **Instructions**

- 1. Identify those risks that your drivers face (get feedback from the drivers, check records, use surveys and observations).
- 2. With the input of managers, staff, or others conduct a risk analysis for each hazard.
- 3. Use the Quantified Risk Scale to determine a risk score for each hazard.
- 4. List logical control measures.
- 5. Assign responsibilities for implementation.
- 6. List the accountable bodies or individuals who will monitor and review the effectiveness of measures taken.
